Rates of pay

Property maintenance

- Carry out all types of general farm labouring work and other necessary works e.g. clearing additional land, general earthworks, drains, cutting of tracks, slashing and other tractor work, etc

- Assist with various rural fencing projects.

Pasture improvement

manner. Weed control at GV is primarily done either by boom spraying, spot spraying from a quad bike, tractor
or manually.
