All applicants need to be over 18 years of age, non-smoking, physically fit, self-motivated, and capable of carrying out strenuous physical labor, they must also possess the desirable skills, experience, and qualifications relevant to the position we have on offer. Farming, fencing and or agricultural plumbing experience is preferred.

Ideal candidates will enjoy working outdoors in a rural type setting, and not afraid to chip in and get your hands dirty doing a range of behind-the-scenes tasks associated with maintaining and operating a large rural property. Remuneration
